



The trained professionals at Dog Paddle K9 Aquatics and Conditioning Centre can be your facilitators as you help your dog be the best they can be and live a great quality of life while having fun!

Whether you want your dog to:

*burn energy, learn to swim, use up extra calories, boost confidence, build muscle, increase range of motion, learn to walk again, increase core strength and body awareness, reduce muscle spasms, adjust spine subluxations, have a coat or nail trim.. just float and let the water work its magic on sore joints and muscles, or come in for one last swim for palliative care dogs....**we are here to help make it happen!***

With your veterinarians' input, we can help your dog as they recuperate from injury or surgery.

A combination of aquatics, massage, chiropractic and land-based core strengthening exercises will improve the quality of your dogs' life in so many ways and help prevent injury while having fun!

All sessions are by appointment. Contact us by email, Facebook, text, or phone.

We ask you give us 24 hrs notice of cancellation so we can fill your time slot with another pet. (a cancellation fee will be applied for less than 24 hrs notice)

Payment is a time of service in the form of cash, debit or credit card.

We have a number of cost saving packages (that can be shared for multi-dog families) for you to choose from or you can pay per visit. (good for one year)

Aquatics

In the pool they can: learn to swim, do laps, fetch, play games, have hands-on support with our own form of aquatic body work, or float their aches and pains away- whatever suits your goals, your dog's abilities and needs.

Our aboveground, indoor pool is 12 ft. wide, 24 ft. long, with a water depth of 4 ft. A gentle, virtually chemical-free, sanitizing system keeps water clean, clear and soft. The water is heated to approx. 90 deg F to promote circulation and relax muscles. Wide, no-slip ramps allow for safe and gradual entry and exit.

We prefer to use K9 life jackets and or harnesses on your dog for safety while he/she is in the pool.

Every dog is accompanied in the pool by at least one qualified staff member.

Massage

At our quiet "Oasis" area, your dog can enjoy relief of uncomfortable compensatory muscle tension and spasms with a land-based massage.

Chiropractic

Many dogs have a mis-alignment in their spine or joints. Specific, gentle techniques can be used by our Chiropractor to assist in adjusting them allowing better neuromuscular health and over-all well being.

Conditioning/ Core Strength Training

The “Pump It Up” area is set up for your dog to become more aware of his body, to work his core muscles and mind while you to learn how to work with your dog to properly perform fun Core Conditioning and Strengthening Exercises at home.

Kinesiology Taping

Some dogs need a little extra joint and muscle support with stretchy, adhesive Kinesiology Tape.

Fluff & Buff Grooming is available for dogs who need a little tidying up. Older dogs and dogs with special needs who can't stand on their own are our specialty.

Mobility Products

If your dog needs a help with mobility on land, we have a number of braces, harnesses and wheelchairs to help make their quality of life better, while saving your own body from being hurt.

Float Assist Jackets

For help floating in the water, we have Float Assist gear that is specially made for all breeds!

Diapers and Belly Bands

Some dogs have special needs and require the use of protection from incontinence. We have a number of washable diapers and belly bands to help keep their environment clean.

Cover-Ups

Warm, fuzzy Apres Aquatics and Massage K9 cover-ups are available to help keep your dog warm after their sessions with us.
